Native Americans/Plains Indians Assembly

On Monday, May 7, Mr. Andrew Duneboo came from the Fort Morgan Library & Museum to present an assembly for the third grade students on the Plains Indians. This area was once inhabited by Native Americans called the Plains Indians. This group of people lived in tepees and followed the buffalo that roamed the grasslands of Colorado. He showed artifacts, such as spear points, arrowheads, drums, and a buffalo bladder and skull. He explained to the class about how these people lived. Although he couldn't set up the tepee because of the rain, he showed the class one of the tepee poles and the cover decorated with symbols.
