College Level Courses

At Weldon Valley High School, juniors and seniors have the opportunity to take college level courses through our Distance Learning Program via Morgan Community College. Students may also enroll in vocational programs and general education classes available on the MCC campus. Access to college level coursework is made available through the Post Secondary Options Education Program. In addition, AP Calculus was offered this year via Colorado On-Line Learning (COL).

Graduation Rates and Drop Out Rates

The 2007 Weldon Valley High School graduation rate was 50%, a decrease from 78.6% in 2006. The State graduation rate was 75%. The graduation rate is calculated by tracking movement of students over a four year period while in high school.

The 2007 Weldon Valley High School drop out rate was 1.1% in 2006-07, an improvement from 2005-06. The 2007 State drop out rate was 4.4%. The drop out rate reflects all students in Grades 7-12 who leave school and do not enroll in another educational program or home based program.

Post Graduation Plans for the Class of 2008

The Class of 2008 was comprised of 22 graduates. Twenty seven percent (27%) of the graduates planned to attend a four-year college, fifty five percent (55%) planned to attend a two-year college and nine percent (18%) planned to enter the workforce. Ninety percent (80%) of the college bound seniors received one or more scholarships to help finance their college education.



Graduation Requirements at Weldon Valley High School

Graduation requirements are based on the units of credit earned in Grades 9-12. Credit is earned at the rate of .5 unit (credit) per semester per class in which the student achieves a passing grade. A minimum of 24 credits is required to meet graduation requirements. These credits include:
