

Weldon Valley School District RE-20J
Board of Education Regular Meeting
February 15, 2011

The regular session of the Board of Education was called to order by President Kathy Wood at 7:03 p.m. Roll Call was answered by Jeff Brown, Rob Chilson, Sheryl Groves, Tracy Parachini, and Kathy Wood. Also in attendance were Superintendent Bob Petterson and Executive Secretary Jennifer Piepho. Audience members were Principal John Karbula and Kelly Haller.

Reports:

Accountability Report: Mr. Karbula reported to the Board that they voted for the Warriors of the Month for February and they will be Cody Covelli for Elementary, Alexandria Allen for Secondary, and Danny Riddle as the Adult Volunteer.

Assessment Report: Kelly Haller reported to the Board that the third grade will be doing CSAP's next Tuesday and Wednesday and the rest of the CSAP's will be administered in March. She has called all sixteen substitutes to come in and help with the tests and also said that every room in the school will be used for students that need accommodated. She explained to the Board why some student's need accommodations. Mr. Petterson commented on how well Kelly did during her training sessions Kelly also reported that the second part of the Scantron tests are complete and the teachers have the results from those tests.

Principal Report: Mr. Karbula gave the Board a handout on the Scantron tests and discussed some of the results. He then reported that the last professional development day for this year will be on March 4th. They will finish the last chapter of the Marzano book and also work on the new state standards. He said the teachers will start teaching with the new standards in March so they will have a head start rather than starting in the fall.
